

Step 1 - Click on the link <https://1drv.ms/u/s!AmtzuvroEbDAbZ5UcjooSe9C3xk?e=DH1q7c>

Step 2 - You will be taken to a One Drive link and you shall see the Tippni - 2078 Official Shrinathji Temple Pradhanpeeth.ics file available for download

Step 3 - Click on the download option

Step 4 - Once you click on the download, you will see a list of tithis, with the option on top right - Add All

Step 5 - Click on **Add All**; you will get an option to save it to a calendar either locally or on icloud. Choose the preferred location

Success. You have successfully imported the calendar entries and starting 13th April, 2021 you shall start seeing the tithis on your Calendar app.

You can now also search for specific tithis such as Deepawali or Holi as well as utsavs and janmatithis.
